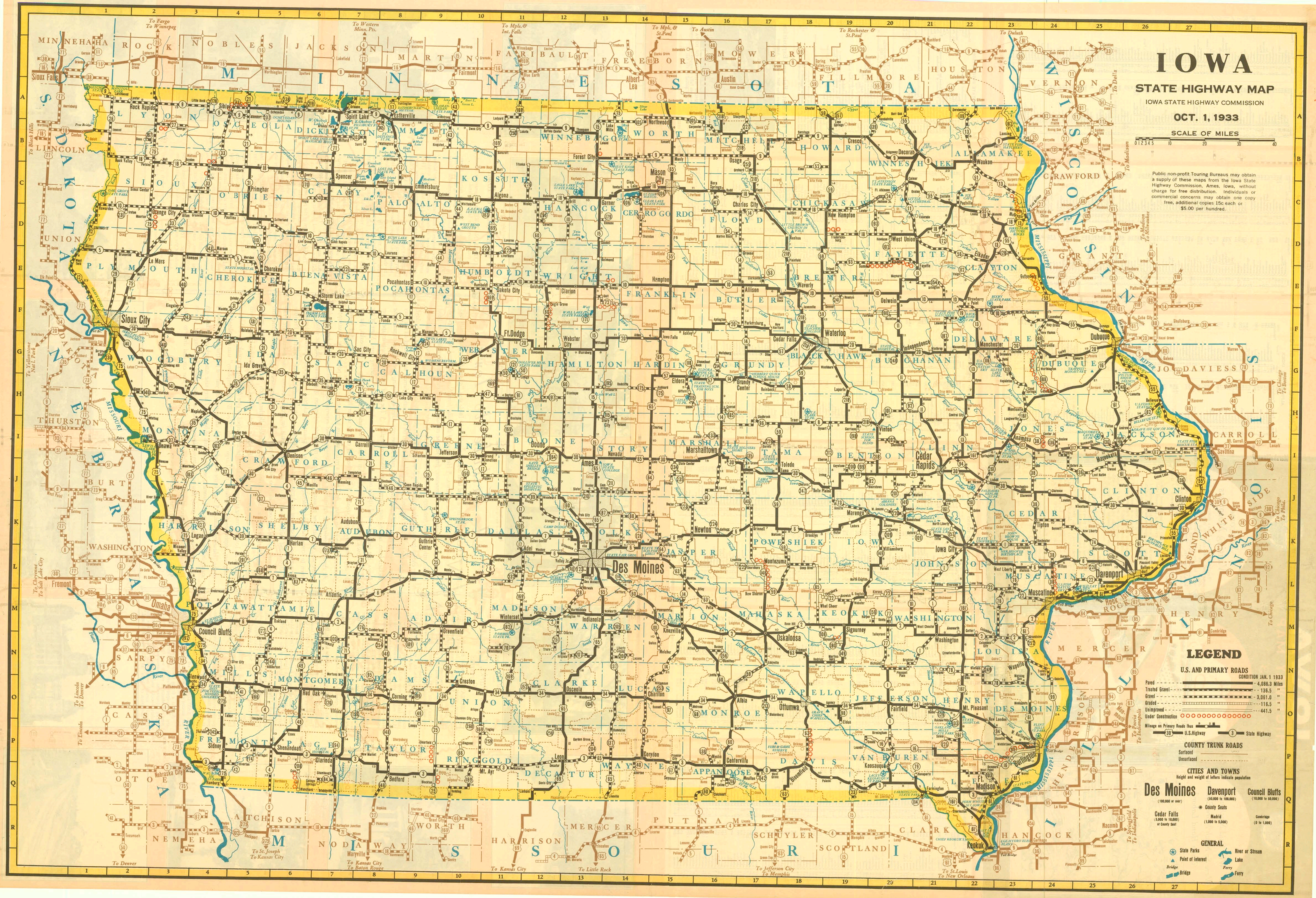
STATE HIGHWAY MAP
